Build a Computer Camp

For students 12 – all ages.

Students will learn to identify and install computer components, work with files and folders, and perform software installations. They will also learn to set-up, configure, maintain, troubleshoot and perform

preventative maintenance on the hardware and software components of a personal computer workstation. Tired of having to call someone for help everytime your click doesn't do what you want? Empower yourself with this knowledge that is appropriate for students of all ages.
