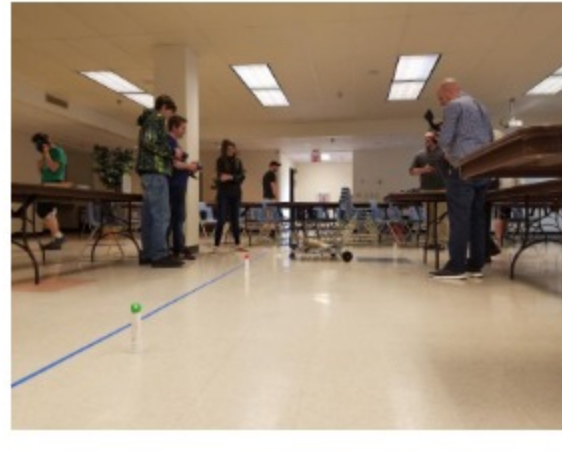
Alumni Spotlight - Alex Rodriguez

Engineering Technology Robot Project



Second-year Engineering Technology (ET) students in the Mechanical Design course, design and build robotic vehicles as a final course project. The vehicles are radio-controlled, with servo steering, and a servo-controlled gripper with tilt.

The vehicles run an obstacle course with challenges such as retrieving balls and returning the balls to the finish line. The students make design choices about the type of drive system, placement of wheels, steering system, and retrieval method.

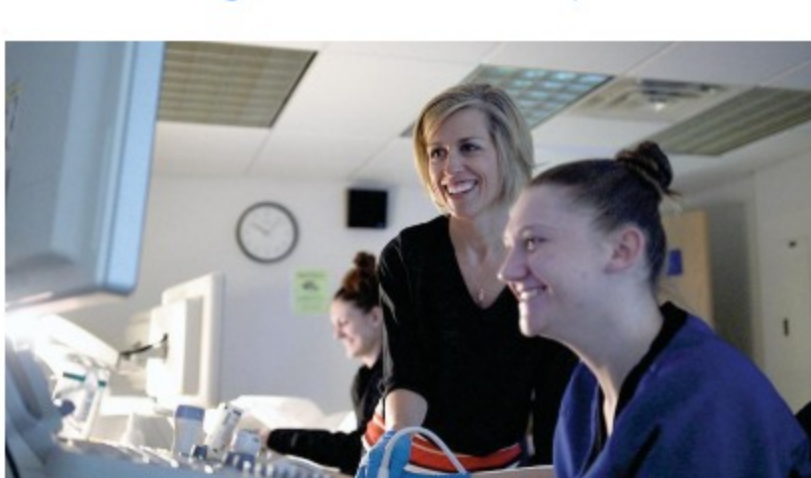
