In March, South Hills completed the second offering of the "Pro-Pilot" training class. The 18-hour, intensive training program is one facet of the overall Drone Initiative at the school.


Drone technology is now being utilized in the fields of Engineering, Defense, Agriculture, Law Enforcement, Information Systems, and the Entertainment Industry.
